

THE CHILDREN'S MINISTRY IS CHANGING THE WAY YOU CHECK YOUR KIDS IN AND OUT OF SERVICE!

Parents: You are going to be more involved!!! YAY! Woo-hoo! Awesome!!!

We decided to make this change for a couple reasons.

1. Our church is growing and we do not know all of you; there are so many new families.
2. We want a safer, more stream-lined drop off and pick up procedure so parents will have more confidence in knowing the location of their children.

There have been no instances to precede this decision, just research into different procedures and policies other large churches follow.

Starting Saturday, February 5th when you drop off your 1st-5th grader (that's right YOU drop them off, no more letting them run into class on their own) you've got to come into either Jr. or Kids Church and sign them in and get a number. You then write down that number next to your child's name.

OK~ That was check in. Here's check out:

Starting Saturday, February 5th when service is over, instead of us letting your kids go and come find you, **YOU MUST** come into either Jr. or Kids church and pick up your child with the same number you received when you dropped off your child.

It is similar to the procedure we follow in the preschool age classrooms, similar.

No one under 18 may drop off or pick up your child.
You, the parent or guardian, should be the one dropping them off or picking them up.

We would appreciate your cooperation with this new procedure.
This policy will be effective starting Saturday, February 5th.
